



<b>Myanmar</b> <i>*take effect on Aug 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- RDT within 48 hours before departure, if fully vaccinated</li> <li>- RT-PCR test within 48 hours before departure, if not fully vaccinated</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Negative pre-departure test result, for travellers who are not fully vaccinated</li> <li>- COVID 19 medical insurance purchased from Myanma Insurance (Diplomats and UN officials including their families may present such an insurance purchased from other sources)</li> </ul> <p><i>Note: Proof of recovery (positive test result and quarantine evidence) to be submitted to MOH for approval of entry granted on a case-by-case basis.</i></p>	RDT on arrival*	3 days at designated hotels (Diplomats and UN officials including their families may choose a 3-day quarantine at own accommodation)
<b>The Philippines</b>	Not Applicable. No entry provision for such foreign travellers.			
<b>Singapore</b>	Nil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <a href="#">SG Arrival Card</a></li> <li>- Proof of recovery 14-90 days before departure: (i) medical discharge memo, or (ii) positive PCR test or professionally-administered ART result</li> <li>- Entry approval (for short-term visitors only)</li> </ul>	PCR test at the end of quarantine	7 days at own accommodation
<b>Thailand</b>	Nil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Travellers with a history of COVID-19 infection who have recovered by medical treatment, and travellers who have received at least one dose of an approved vaccine post-infection must have a certificate of COVID-19 recovery.</li> </ul>	Nil	Nil

<sup>1</sup> Common terminology: Antigen Rapid Test (ART), Reverse Transcription (RT) - Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Test, Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT), Ministry of Health (MOH)

<sup>3</sup> Quarantine requirement is stated in the context of negative result for COVID-19 testing after arrival, where required.
